

# Fors33 Privacy Policy

**1. Introduction** This Privacy Policy dictates how Fors33 ("we", "our", or "us") collects, utilizes, and protects the information associated with your use of our website, APIs, and software services (collectively, the "Services"). By accessing the Services, you acknowledge the data practices outlined in this document.

**2. The Absolute Boundary: Local Execution** Fors33 provides cryptographic and data integrity tools designed to operate on your local infrastructure. **We do not collect, ingest, host, or analyze the raw contents of your datasets, files, or local volumes.** Our software generates cryptographic proofs locally. We only interact with the metadata necessary to validate licenses and ensure system integrity.

**3. Information We Collect** To provide and secure the Services, we collect specific categories of operational data:

- **Identity and Access Data:** When you authenticate using third-party providers such as Google Workspace, we receive your email address, basic profile information, and necessary OAuth tokens to provision your operator seats and validate your identity.
- **Billing Information:** If you subscribe to a paid tier, our payment processor (Stripe) collects your billing details. Fors33 retains transaction histories, subscription statuses, and billing addresses, but we do not store raw credit card numbers on our servers.
- **Communication Data:** Information you provide when requesting support, submitting a contact form, or downloading compliance materials (such as email captures).
- **System and Telemetry Data:** We log automated technical data when you interact with our APIs or website. This includes IP addresses, browser types, request timestamps, and cryptographic key validation requests to monitor for abuse and ensure rate limits.

**4. How We Use Your Information** We process the collected data strictly for operational execution:

- To authenticate your identity and authorize access to designated software tiers.
- To process subscription payments and issue cryptographic license keys (F33 keys).
- To deliver system status updates, security alerts, and critical administrative notices.
- To detect, investigate, and prevent fraudulent activity or violations of our Acceptable Use Policy.

**5. Third-Party Service Providers** We do not sell your personal data to data brokers or advertising networks. We share necessary data strictly with trusted infrastructure partners required to operate the Services:

- Authentication providers (e.g., Google) to verify your identity.
- Payment gateways (e.g., Stripe) to securely process transactions.
- Cloud hosting and logging infrastructure to maintain API uptime and security.

**6. Data Security and Retention** We implement industry-standard security protocols to protect the data we do hold. However, no transmission over the internet or electronic storage system is entirely secure. You are responsible for securing your own credentials. We retain your information only for as long as necessary to fulfill the operational purposes outlined in this policy or to comply with legal obligations.

**7. Operator Rights** Depending on your jurisdiction, you may have the right to request access to, correction of, or deletion of the personal data we hold about you. You may initiate these requests by contacting our support channels. Please note that requesting the deletion of identity or billing data will immediately terminate your active subscriptions and revoke your license keys.

**8. Policy Modifications** We reserve the right to update this Privacy Policy at our discretion. Any modifications will be posted on this page with an updated revision date. Continued use of the Services following such changes constitutes your acknowledgment of the updated practices.

**9. International Data Transfers** Fors33 operates within the United States. If you access our Services from outside the United States, be aware that your information will be transferred to, stored, and processed in our facilities and by those third parties with whom we share it. By using the Services, you consent to this transfer, recognizing that data protection laws in the United States may differ from those in your jurisdiction.

**10. Region-Specific Rights (EEA, UK, and California)** If you are a resident of the European Economic Area (EEA), the United Kingdom, or the State of California, you possess specific statutory rights regarding your personal data. These include the right to data portability, the right to restrict or object to our processing of your data, and the right not to face discriminatory treatment for exercising your privacy rights. **11. Children's Privacy** Our Services are engineered for commercial and enterprise operators. They are strictly not intended for individuals under the age of eighteen. We do not knowingly collect personal data from minors. If we become aware that we have inadvertently collected such information, we will take immediate steps to delete it from our systems.
